

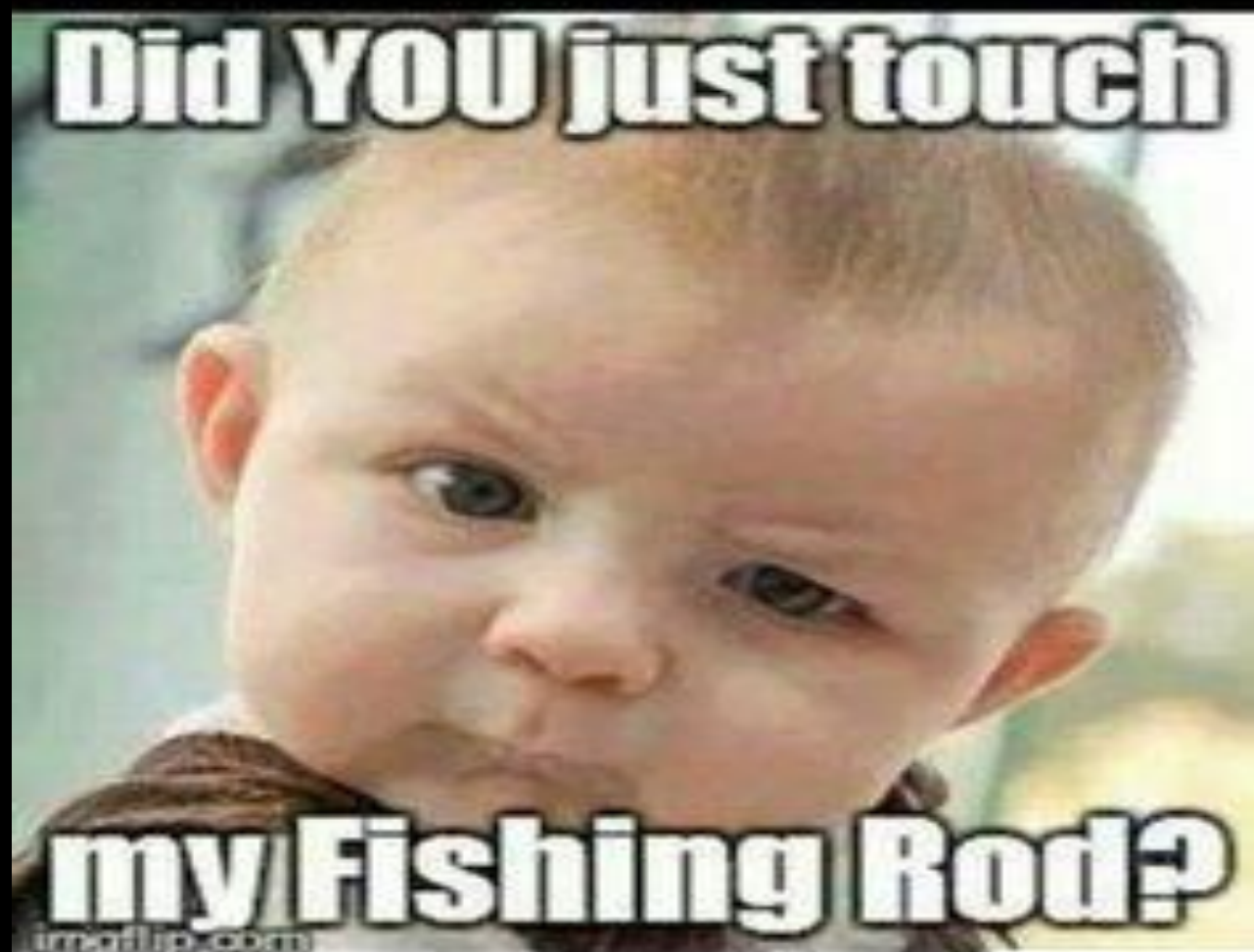

# *How not to do Evangelism!*

**Evangelism is not done at a distance or by looking down on people. Evangelism is done by engaging people where they are and mixing it up with the other sinners like us.**

Paul talks about how he is the least of the Apostles. Isaiah cries he is a man of unclean lips unworthy to speak for God. Peter falls to his knees and tells Jesus to go away because he is a sinner.

**Isaiah's call, Paul's call, and Peters  
call all illustrate a simple  
understanding of how God works:**

**"God doesn't call the  
qualified!  
God qualifies the called!"**



***Jesus calls us where we are  
and asks only for the gifts  
we already have and to use  
them for the kingdom.***

**"Do not be afraid; from now  
on you will be catching  
people."**

**At the end of the  
day it is all about  
Relationships!**

You could be baptized 100 times. Communed every Sunday your whole life and never missed worship. Read the Bible cover to cover. Go to Seminary School and become a pastor. But if God doesn't act on our behalf and touch us with a love that compels us to love each other and love our enemies. To forgive as we have been forgiven. To act justly with the same righteousness God shows for us. **WE ARE LOST!**

Isaiah asks.**

*In Jesus Christ we are  
living the restored  
relationship now and we  
are qualified and sent out  
to tell the world they are  
included!*
