So, God appeared in a vision (literally a dream) and promised him that he would have a child. The issue that has been argued for centuries are the words:

"And he believed the Lord; and the Lord reckoned it to him as righteousness."

- Genesis 15:6



Traditional understanding is the God <u>makes</u> Abram righteous for believing.

(Romans, Galatians, and James)

Remember Abram is asleep!

Other interpretations are:

God is recognized by Abram as the one who is righteous for doing this thing.

Abram is righteous because he believes. (works righteous)

When we speak are our words negative or hurtful? Do they cause pain or suffering or do they promote faith, hope, and trust?

Without faith, hope and trust, there is no promise for the future, and without a promising future, life has no direction, no meaning and no justification.

Paul's letter to the Philippians from prison expresses faith, hope and trust even under dire and difficult circumstances. "Join in imitating me,..."

"Don't let the alligators get you down."



Jesus tells those warning him about Herod that he has work to do. This all sounds rather ominous and negative. It is not!

Jesus says that this work takes three days

(τέλειος- Be perfected) This is a reference to the resurrection for our benefit reminding us of the promise and to hold fast.

and the third day it is finished.

Spend time with people that pour water on your fears doubts and gasoline on your dreams.

In spite of our lack of faith and in spite of all the negativity and our unwillingness, God still saves unconditionally and graciously!
