Wrong Question!

Jeremiah is writing either during the siege of Jerusalem or during the fall.

The message is that no matter how bad it appears, God is leading us to freedom and life!

Only God can turn
a **MESS** into a
message, a **TEST** into a
testimony, a **TRIAL** into
a triumph, a **VICTIM**
into a victory.

Jesus' message in Luke isn't about the end of time..it isn't about interpreting the signs of the end either.

What many fail to
realize is:

Luke is describing
the resurrection!
