Dualism:

Is one of the most recurring and popular Christian Heresies of all time dating back to the 2nd century. Basically it is the separating the spirit/soul (which is thought of as being good and coming from God) and the body (which is thought of as being bad and coming from the devil).

Dualism leads to the idea that there is a battle of Good and Evil that is either going on in the created world or inside ourselves.

Some think the reason for temptation is so we can give our "yes" to God and our "no" to Satan/Devil.

The Sixth Petition (Small Catechism)

And lead us not into temptation.

What does this mean? God tempts no one. We pray in this petition that God would guard and keep us so that the devil, the world, and our sinful nature may not deceive us or mislead us into false belief, despair, and other great shame and vice. Although we are attacked by these things, we pray that we may finally overcome them and win the victory.









Jesus uses the Scripture to counter each of the devils temptations.

That is a message to us how we are to counter the temptations of this life.

You need a faith community to do it in and use as resource and sounding board. So it just isn't you making the decisions.

And don't forget Prayer...why do we pray?
